Prof. Sarah Michiels graduated in 2005 as a physiotherapist and in 2008 as a manual therapist. Since then, she works as a physiotherapist/manual therapist. In 2015 she defended her PhD on neck-related tinnitus complaints at the University of Antwerp. During her post-doc at the University of Antwerp, she continued this research, now focusing on temporomandibular related tinnitus. Since 2020 Sarah is appointed as an assistant professor in musculoskeletal rehabilitation at Hasselt University, continuing her research in the tinnitus field. In the meantime, she is also part of the multidisciplinary tinnitus team of the Antwerp university hospital. Here she is responsible for diagnostic assessment and treatment of patients with somatic tinnitus.
